WHEREAS the AUTHOR of the TRUST has decided herself to be a life trustee and has also requested her husband Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj, aged 43, S/o. Mr. D. Karuthudayan residing at 190, North Main Road, Anna Nagar West Extension, Madras 600 101 to be a life trustee to carry out the objects of the Trust and Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj has given his consent to act as trustee by his letter of even date.

WHEREAS it has been considered necessary to execute a deed of Trust declaring the objects of the Trust and powers and duties of the Trustees for the time being:

NOW THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH:-

1. The Trust shall bear the name of "GREEN VALLEY EDUCATIONAL TRUST".
2. The author of the Trust doth hereby endow a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) as a nucleus fund for the Charitable objects.
3. The Office of the Trust shall be at No.4, Sathalvar Street, Mugappair West, Madras 600 050 or such other place or places as may be decided by the trustees from time to time.
4. OBJECTS: The objects for which the Trust is created are:
  - a. To run educational institutions for the benefit of the public and in particular to take over and run schools, colleges and to run resorts for the senior citizens.
  - b. To carry out all other charitable activities including relief for the poor, medical relief and the advancement of any other objects of General Public Utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit or, for any other purposes as defined in the income reliefs provided under the said Act.
  - c. To support and undertake rural developmental activities directly or through other Trusts and Societies.
  - d. To run alongside any industry or business to augment the resources of the Trust.
  - e. To purchase, borrow, acquire, hold, manage, sell or transfer all or any movable & immovable properties possessed or acquired or purchased by the Trust for executing the objects of the Trust.
  - f. To institute and grant scholarships, stipends and assistance and render financial aid to students, teachers and any other deserving person to render assistance to such persons of Indian origin or others while they are in India to promote the objects of the Trust.

THE TRUST FUND SHALL CONSIST OF:

a. The said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) above referred to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the TRUSTEES.

b. Any money, properties, movables, immovables that may be acquired by purchase, gift or donation or otherwise, all manner of right, titles or interest over any properties, that may be acquired from time to time in the aforesaid manner.

c. All additions and accretions to the Trust property.

d. All voluntary donations, gifts, Corpus Funds, legacies and grants in cash or in kind accepted by the Trustee.

e. All the properties and income of the Trust shall be held solely for the object of the Trust.

5. FOUNDER TRUSTEES: The Trustees named in this deed of Trust namely Dr. Mrs. Daisy Dharmaraj and Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj shall be termed the Founder trustees and shall constitute the Board. They shall hold their office for their lives. Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj shall be the first Managing Trustee and Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

6. CO-OPTED TRUSTEES: The Founder Trustees shall be two in number and shall function as the Board of Trustees. It shall be open to the Founder Trustees acting as a Board, to co-opt two additional Trustees. Such additional Trustees be termed as co-opted Trustees. Such co-opted Trustees shall hold office only for a period of 3 years from the date of such co-option, after which period he or she shall cease to be a trustee. The co-opted Trustee or Trustees shall be deemed to have vacated their office earlier on the following contingencies:

a. If he/she does not desire to continue in office and resigns the office of the Trustee.

b. If he/she is adjudged insolvent.

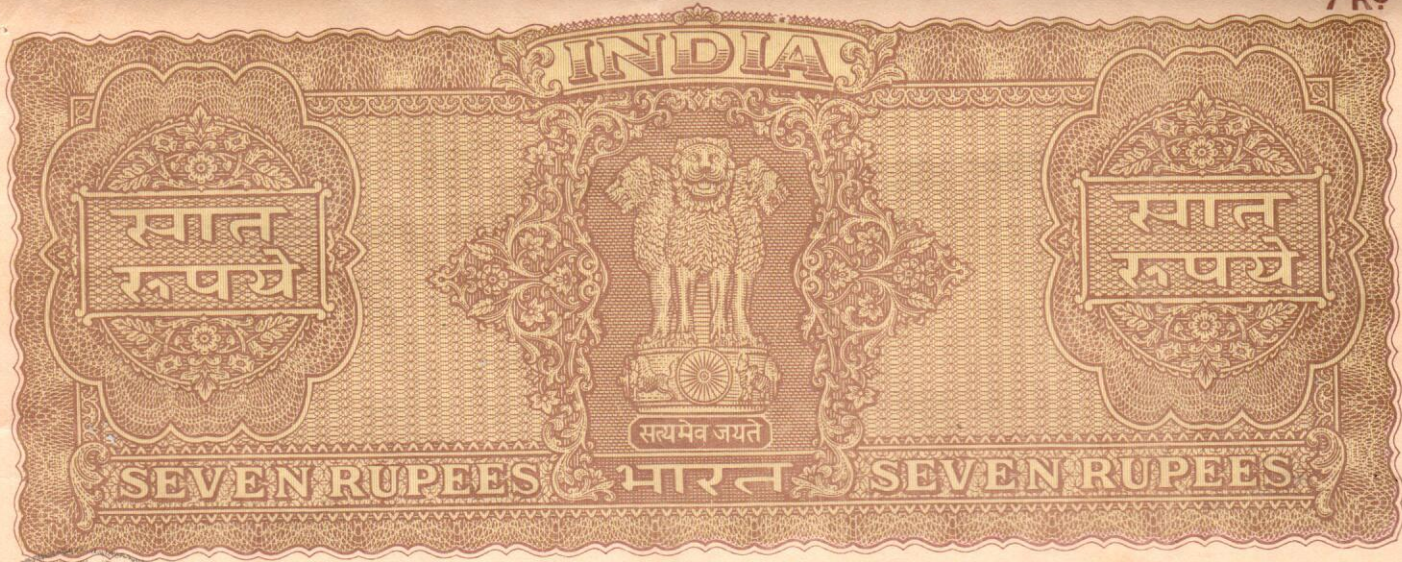

THE TRUST FUND SHALL CONSIST OF  
the sum of Rs. 10000/- (Ten thousand rupees) which has been acknowledged by the TRUSTEES.  
And money, property, movable, immovable, and any other assets which may be acquired from time to time in the course of the business of the Trust shall be added to the fund.  
All decisions and actions and acted on by the Trust shall be valid and binding on all the members of the Trust.  
All voluntary donations, gifts, contributions and other moneys or in kind accepted by the Trust shall be added to the fund.  
All the priorities and claims of the Trust shall be satisfied in the order of their priority.  
The Trust shall be managed by the Trustees and the Trust shall be liable for the debts and liabilities of the Trust.  
The Trustees shall be entitled to receive remuneration for their services as Trustees and shall be entitled to reimbursement of all expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their duties as Trustees.  
The Trustees shall be entitled to sue and be sued in their individual capacities and shall not be liable for the debts and liabilities of the Trust.

- c. If he/she suffers from any illness affecting his/her mental capacity.
- d. If he/she suffers from any chronic illness physically preventing him/her from functioning as Trustee for a continuous period of six months.
- e. If by a majority decision of the Trustees the co-opted Trustee is expelled for reasons that such Trustee's action is prejudicial to the object and intent of the Trust.

7. **SUBSTITUTED TRUSTEES:** Whenever any vacancy is caused, by reason of any founder Trustee vacating his or her office, by reason whatsoever, the nominee of such Trustee if such nomination has been made, shall automatically be nominated to the Board in place of vacated Founder Trustee and such nominated person or persons shall hold the office of Trusteeship for his/her life unless he/she vacates the office of Trusteeship for any of the reasons contemplated as above. In the event of there being no nomination by such Founder Trustee, the remaining founder Trustees shall have a right to jointly nominate a person.

8. **OTHER TRUSTEES:** Whenever a vacancy occurs by reasons of the co-opted Trustee vacating office under clause 6 above, or by the substituted Trustee vacating this office under clause 7 above, then in all such cases, the Board of Trustees may fill up such vacancy by co-opting a person to fill up the vacancy at a meeting, and the resolution being carried by a majority of the Trustees then present at the meeting. The office of any co-opted Trustee who vacates office by reason of expiry of the period of 3 years fixed herein above shall be filled up by the Founder Trustees by co-option and the Trustee vacating the office may be co-opted again.

9. **CHAIRMAN:** Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj, one of the Founder Trustees of the Trust shall be the First Chairman and shall also be the Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustees and shall hold office as Chairman, Managing Trustee until he declines to hold office or until by a majority resolution, the Board of Trustees decide to appoint any other Trustee to the said office in which event the said Dr. Jacob Dharmaraj shall vacate office.

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10. **MEETINGS:** The Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall convene meetings of the Board whenever he considers necessary provided nevertheless, that at least one meeting of the Board be endeavoured to be convened and held once in every three months.
11. **QUORUM:** The quorum for the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 2 Trustees personally present at the meeting.
12. **RESOLUTION:** At all the meetings of the Board, the Chairman shall preside, and in his absence, one of the Trustees present shall be elected to act as a Chairman for that meeting. All resolutions passed at the meeting should be duly recorded in a book maintained for that purpose and duly signed by the Chairman of the meeting. Any resolution declared as passed in the said meeting shall be conclusive and binding on all the Trustees and shall be given full effect to. All questions relating to the administration of the Trust shall be decided by the majority of the Trustees either at the meeting of the Board of Trustees duly constituted or by circulation of the concerned papers, provided that circulation is made to all the trustees who are present within the city. At all meeting of the Board, the resolutions should be decided by show of hands, and in case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have and exercise a second or casting vote.
13. **SUB-COMMITTEE:** It shall be open to the Board of Trustees to constitute a sub-committee among themselves to attend to the day to day administration of the Trust, and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall always be the ex-office Chairman of all such committees. The committee so constituted shall have such powers as may be delegated to them by the Board of Trustees, and shall have the power to employ such staff, consultants, workers etc. for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
14. **ADMINISTRATION:** The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and to do all acts, deeds and things which are calculated to fulfil the objects of the Trust for which the Trust is created.
15. **POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:**
- a. The Trustees shall be entitled to use the Trust funds and such moneys or properties as may become available from time to time for the purpose of carrying out the objects aforesaid.

- b. The Trustees, if they find necessary, shall be entitled to collect donations, fees, legacies, interest, grants etc. for the furtherance and advancement of the objects of the Trust either for Corpus by way of endowment or otherwise for necessary expenses.
- c. The Trustees may invest the Trust Fund in such securities and business as they think fit, in the interest of Trust without contravening the provisions of the INCOME TAX ACT, 1961.
- d. The income from all Trust properties and investments and projects shall be devoted for the purposes of the Trust as may be decided by the Trustees from time to time and if necessary can be accumulated.
- e. The Trustees shall have power to lease out or sell trust properties or piece of trust properties for meeting the requirement of the objectives/projects of the Trust.
- f. The Trustees shall have power to raise loans with or without securities for the purposes of the Trust, and to repay the same with or without interest from out of the income derived from the Trust properties, investments and funds or out of the donations earmarked for the purpose of repayment or debts.
- g. The Trustees shall keep and maintain accounts of all the Trust properties and the accounting year of the Trust shall be the year ending on 31st March every year. The said account shall be audited every year by qualified Auditor, or Auditors elected by the Trustees every year and the Audited Statement shall be signed by the Managing Trustee.
- h. The Managing Trustee shall have powers to empower, nominate or authorise any person or persons to carry on such function as he is assigned to in these presents, but such nominated or appointed person shall have no power to sell, borrow, lease, donate, mortgage or dispose of any of the properties of the Trust without the written consent of the Managing Trustee
- i. The Managing Trustee shall have the right to renew or suspend any of the Trustees without assigning any reason whatsoever and his conduct shall not be questioned by any trustee so renewed or suspended or still remaining as a trustee.

j. The Managing Trustee and other trustees shall be entitled to such reasonable remuneration and other benefits they may fix for the services rendered by them to the trust.

16. BANK ACCOUNTS: The Board of Trustees shall open one or more accounts in the name of the trust with any Scheduled Bank or Nationalised Bank and the said account shall be operated by the Managing Trustee and any other Trustees to be named by the Board of Trustees from time to time, either jointly or individually.

All amounts received to the credit of the Trust shall be forthwith credited to the Banking Account of the Trust.

17. LIABILITY OF TRUSTEES: The Trustees shall not be liable for any loss that may be caused to the Trust Funds, unless the Trustee is found guilty of fraud or criminal breach of Trust by a competent court of law, likewise the private liabilities of the Trustees shall not affect the Trusts.

18. INDEMNITY: Every Trustee, for the time being, shall be indemnified out of the assets of the Trust funds against any liability incurred by him in any proceedings, either civil or criminal, in which the judgement is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted, provided the said proceedings relate to any matter arising out of the administration of any act lawfully and bonafide done by him as TRUSTEE.

19. UTILISATION OF TRUST FUNDS: No part of the Trust, either the Corpus or the Income therefrom shall be utilised for any purpose other than that of the projects of the Trust hereby created and shall be utilised for the benefit of the public.

20. The Board of Trustees may by any supplementary instrument confer and provide for such powers as may be required or found necessary for the proper administration of the TRUST.

21. Everything which may be done by the Founder Trustees above named from the date of this instrument to the date of registration thereof shall be binding on the Trust as having been done by them in the capacity of Trustees.

22. 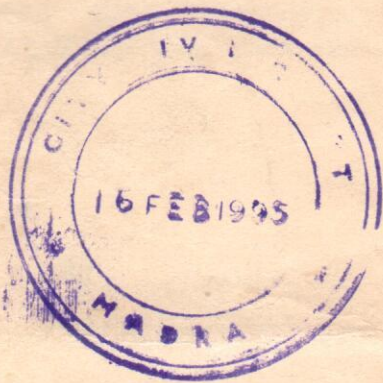
